2023 promises to be a great year for DSRC! With full membership and careful planning by our Board of Directors, we have several capital improvements planned prior to opening day. Last year we were able to do a wide range of new improvements, from tennis court resurfacing to upgrades to our bath house and pool.

The largest project we are planning for the coming year will be repairs to our parking lot, a new entryway sign and other needed updates to our facility and equipment.

Any additional donations by members, as you submit dues payment, continue to help us pay for these and many other capital improvements. Thank you and please consider giving again.

The Board of Directors has voted to increase annual dues by \$30 to \$725 for the 2023 season. We have managed to keep our dues stable for nearly a decade but with rising cost of labor and goods we raised dues in order to adequately provide a safe environment and make needed upgrades to our facility.

We will continue using our MemberSplash database for dues payments. Membersplash has added a 'card on file' option, so that you can pay all your bills without having to type in your credit card information. This card will NOT be automatically charged for dues bills but will make it easier to quickly pay bills when they are due. Please consider adding a card to your account to simplify billing, this information is safely and securely held on a secure server, not by DSRC.

All credit card dues payments will immediately be reflected as 'paid status' in your family's account using the secure platform. Online payments will be made with <u>no service charge</u>, therefore we are encouraging all members to pay online. Any payments made by check will put the account into 'pending status' for payments until we have received and processed your check.

Please check the email address on file in your Membersplash account. All emails are populated from the email that you have recorded in your Membersplash account. Also, if you want to change the adult that is the 'billing' adult please email GM, Dave Hardy, at gm@dsrclub.com, this email will receive account payment reminders and bills.
